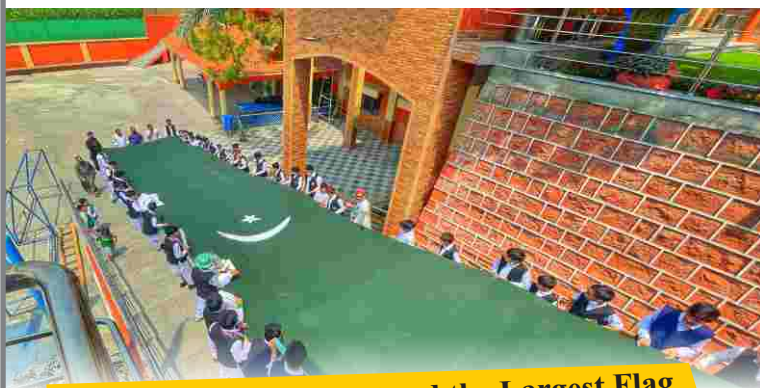
Inauguration of Newly Built Multi-Purpose Mega Auditorium

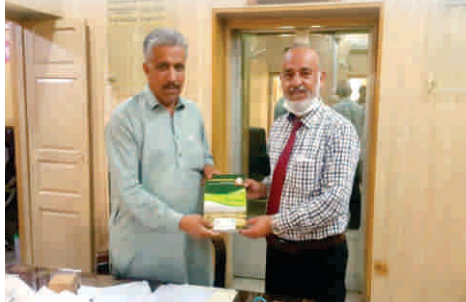
Interactive workshop on Paper Presentation

F.Sc-I Entrance Tests 2021

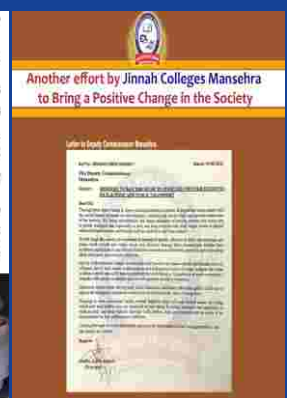
